Trails Oversight Committee Meeting
February 24, 2021

The Trails Oversight Committee meeting was held via virtual meeting (Zoom) on February 24, 2021. Doug Milburn hosted the virtual meeting.

- A. CALL TO ORDER:** Mr. Nelson called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.
- B. OPEN FORUM:** LRPRA residents John Maher and Harry Wiggins presented comments to the committee.
- C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Minutes of the June 4, 2021 Trails Oversight Committee meeting were unanimously approved.
- D. DISCUSSION:** Neil Nelson stated that the purpose of the meeting is to review the Occoquan Greenway Trail map and language for trail signs, sent to LRPRA by PWC Dept of Parks, Recreation and Tourism (DPRT) on Feb 16, 2021; and to prepare the response to DPRT. The committee proceeded with review and discussion of the map and sign, and recommends this response to DPRT:

Corridor Ownership / Trail Sign:

- 1) Use correct name – **Lake Ridge Parks and Recreation Association, Inc.** (in place of Lake Ridge Park and Recreation Association).
- 2) Use the Lake Ridge logo on the sign (and map), as shown below.



The logo should replace LAKE RIDGE
Association

Occoquan Greenway Map:

- 1) Use the Lake Ridge logo
- 2) Indicate that the segments currently open for public use have blue blaze markings
- 3) Add segment length to the map, displayed with Segment number near the line marking the trail route. For example, Segment 1 should indicate 3.6 miles.
- 4) The committee noted that the Greenway map currently shows planned trail routes crossing a privately-owned parcel on Tanyard Hill Road, in the Segment 8 area (shown on the map below). This may have been intentional. The committee wishes to ensure that DPRT is aware of this and that it may raise questions.
